Initial Review

Manuscripts submitted by authors are preliminary screened for quality and appropriateness of the content of the manuscript by the Editorial Board.

II. Peer Review Process

The manuscripts which are passed through the initial screening process will be preceded for peer reviewing process. The reviewers are assigned for the manuscript by the editorial board.

III. Decision

Based on the evaluation reports of reviewers the Editorial Board will make the final decision on acceptance or rejection of the manuscript.

4. General format of the journal article

Prepare your manuscript including (1) Title Page (2) Abstract (3) Main text (Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion) (4) References (5) Tables and (6) Figures.

I. Title Page

The title page should include:

- The name(s) of the author(s)
- A concise and informative title
- The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)
- The e-mail address, and telephone number(s) of the corresponding author

II. Abstract

Please provide an abstract of less than 200 words. The abstract should be an objective reflection of the article. Abstract should contain the research problem, methodology, results and conclusion and policy relevance in very brief. This should also include five keywords in which specific to the particular article.

III. Main Text

Introduction – includes the problem addressed, current level of knowledge, the aim of the study, and the hypothesis tested.

Materials and Methods – provide all information of the data, sample & methods of analysis in order to allow replication of the study.

Results and Discussion – Explain and discuss the results in a larger context of study discipline and literature, and gives the scientific contribution of the study.

Conclusion – Explain the main conclusions of the study in the text all quoted and paraphrased citation of other authors, as well as other works of

The contributing author(s) must be properly referenced.

IV. References and citations

Author should follow the APA referencing system for the citations within the text and for the list of references. Place references at the end of the article and the references should be placed in alphabetical order. Only cited works should be included in the reference list.

V. Tables & Figures

Illustrations, pictures and graphs, should be included with the highest quality and in an electronic format.

- Caption of the table appear above & for other figures below the object.
- Source of tables & figures should be provided below the object and caption.
- Figures/charts and tables created in MS Word should be included in the main text rather than at the end of the document.

5. Text Formatting

Manuscripts should be prepared in MS Word format.

- Font Times New Roman
- Font size 16 Bold (Main topic), 14 Bold (Headings), 12 (Text)
- Word limit Maximum 5000 words
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- Line space: 1.5
- Margins: left 1.5 inch and 1 inch for each side
- Save your file in docx format (Word 2007 or higher) or doc format (older Word

Versions).

6. Acceptance and publication

The Editorial Board will keep you informed as to your article's progress throughout the process. Proofs (with edited word doc in review facility in MS Word) will be sent to the corresponding author and should be returned promptly.

Abbreviations

Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter.

Non-English words

Scientific Names – Italic & "Sinhala words" - within inverted commas

Footnotes

try to avoid footnotes.

Acknowledgment

Acknowledgments of people, grants, funds, etc. The names of funding organizations should be written in full.
